



## **Security Report for Homeowners of Crestmont: February, 2015**

Intervention Group continues to track all patterns and activity within Crestmont in order to modify patrol patterns in response.

Historically, daylight saving brings increased unwanted and/or criminal activity. IGI has begun officer orientation and preparation for this expected spring/summertime increase, and continues to track surrounding neighborhood stats to prevent similar crime waves from encroaching into Crestmont.

IGI received **24** calls for service relating to suspicious persons or vehicles and vendor legitimacy. The majority of calls (16) were received from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. All calls resulted in IGI officer response and clearance.

IGI escorted **15** non-residents out of the Crestmont community after they were observed driving around aimlessly. Upon approach by officers, all agreed to leave without incident. Eight of these incidents occurred between the hours of 11:00 pm and 6:00 am.

### **Home Alarms**

IGI again responded to **8** alarm calls. There was no evidence of criminal activity, but rather alarms resulting from sensor malfunctions or user error.

### **Vacation Watch**

IG received **9** requests for Vacation Watch; there were zero incidents of crime or attempts while registered homeowners were away.

### **Garage Doors:**

There were **4** residents unaware that they left their garage door open. We remind you that open garage doors are an opportunity for theft and potential entry into your home.
