



Security Report for Homeowners of Crestmont: July, 2014

Officers continue to vary roaming patrol hits in an effort to give non-residents the appearance of this area being heavily patrolled.

IGI officers approached the drivers of 9 vehicles, all driving very slowly through the community. Not one accepted officer offer of assistance and none were residents or visitors to residences. All were escorted away from Crestmont.

IGI responded to **27** calls from Crestmont residents regarding suspicious or unfamiliar vehicles and/or persons.

Criminal Activity

IGI has seen an overall decrease in crime and/or suspicious activity in Crestmont within the last 90 days, during which time an increase in crime in other areas of the City has been experienced.

Home Alarms

IGI responded to 3 alarm calls. There was no evidence of criminal activity, but rather alarms resulting from sensor malfunctions or user error.

Vacation Watch

IG received 15 requests for Vacation Watch during March. There were zero incidents of crime or attempts while registered homeowners were away.

Vendors

Officers continue to note new vendors and patrol area frequently to ensure the legitimacy of all vendors.

Garage Doors:

IGI officers observed 5 garage doors left open and unattended. We remind you that open garage doors are open invitations for unwanted individuals to enter your garage and help

themselves. It also could be an invitation for someone to enter, close the garage door and attempt (unobserved) break-in through the interior door.

Area Alerts:

Criminals are working in pairs; if you are approached, limit your interaction for your safety. Consider changing course and carry your cell phone and call IGI at 877-272-8765 if walking in our patrol area.

Remain alert if you are parked and sitting in your car with the windows down. A woman in Glenview was robbed of her purse and cell phone when a man walked beside her car, noticed the items, snatched them in an instant and jumped into a waiting car. Even in hot weather, consider limiting your open windows and/or do not have your personal items visible while you wait.
